

OBJECTIVES

The Webinar will explore the way in which the increasing use of artificially intelligent technologies (AI) affects the practice and administration of law defined in a broad sense.

Students will understand the connection between AI and Law in the context of legal responsibility, law-making, law-enforcing, criminal law, the medical sector and intellectual property law.
