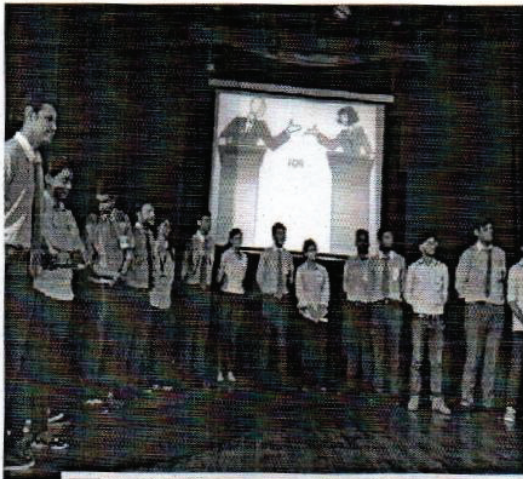
Report: Debate Competition
