





Outcomes: The activity was successfully concluded as students understand importance of power of subconscious mind and how to get rid of ragging activities.



Report: Fireless Cooking Competition - 2019-20




Report: International Women's Day-2020

"Citizenship Amendment Bill: A requirement of the nation"

The Citizenship (Amendment) Bill, 2019 is being introduced in Lok Sabha in December 2019. The 2019 Bill seeks to make illegal migrants who are Hindus, Sikhs, Buddhists, Jains, Parsis and Christians from Afghanistan, Bangladesh and Pakistan, eligible for citizenship. Presently it is most debatable topic and also protested as petitioners says that Bill discriminates against Muslims and violates the right to equality enshrined in the Constitution whereas some says that Bill would not have arisen had Partition not taken place on the basis of religion. The Bill does not snatch citizenship of Muslims and there is no need for them to have any fear. 
The senior students of the University organized a scintillating show and welcomed their new companions to the University in an environment of harmony and friendliness. The audience was
