The author/s must certify that the work is his/her/their original contribution. It should be also mentioned that the paper has not been submitted or accepted for publication elsewhere. The author/s shall be responsible for the facts and opinions made by them.

Author/s of one best paper from each subject area will be awarded Special Honour later.

Peer reviewed selected papers will be published in UGC CARE listed Journal for which additional fee may be charged.

The remaining selected papers will be published after plagiarism check and copyright certificate in the form of an edited book.
