Brief Report & Outcomes:

Athree days skilled and awareness workshop on Soft Skills Development was conducted 30th March 2021 to 01st April 2021by the School of Computer and System Science with the collaboration to School of Humanities for the first year students of BCA and MCA under the guidance of the Director of SCSS, Prof. (Dr.) Harvir Singh. The aim of the workshop is to help the student to build a powerful personality and to stand out and to move forward in your everyday activities to reach their goals. Ms.Rana Zedi was the resource person of the workshop. She is an eminent career counselor who has been associated with counseling and provide guidance to the students.

During the formal inaugural session, Dr. Blessy Thankachan, Asst. Director School of Computer & Systems Sciences welcomed the gathering and also introduced resource persons to the audience and brief about the need of soft skill in our lives.

The session opened by the Introductory part of soft skill by the resource person, Ms. Rana Zediwith introducing the realities of the industry; the serious skills gap & shortage found in the industry, which were evident through various surveys & statistics. Information was disseminated regarding the industry specific soft skills that the ever competitive industry demands. She briefed that the Soft Skill is often associated with a person's "EQ" (Emotional IntelligenceQuotient), the cluster of personality traits, social graces, communication, language, personal habits, interpersonal skills, managing people, leadership, etc. that characterize relationships with other people. Soft skills contrast to hard skills, which are generally easily

quantifiable and measurable. The Session of ten days is based on the Modules of Soft skilled as detailed as below:

Day 1 (30th March 2021): Introduction to Comm. & Soft Skills Induction / Orientation

On the first day, Ms. Zedibrief about the way of communication with various soft skills and difference between Hard skills and soft skills.

Module:

- Why Soft Skills is the need of the hour?

Day 2 (31st March 2021):Grammar (Brush up)

On Second day, she Started with the benefits of English and its Grammar used in English. She recall all the students about the tenses, grammar concepts and for better understanding, she make some of the activity and quiz to make learning easy and interesting.

Module:

- This session helps the candidates to recap the basic grammar concepts and Tenses.
- The session may be presented in a PPT for the better understanding.
- After the brush up, the session is followed by an activity either role play or quiz.

Day 3 (01st April 2021): Activity JAM (Picture perception)

With continuation of third day, Ms. Zedistarted with the topic of body language and expressions. She also briefed about the way of vocabulary used along with the different body language. She used PPT's as a slide show to brief the students in details and ask them to give their own view of the mindset of the picture perception and what the object in the image thinking and briefing and tell them to write the story related to that and ask every student to speak in front to everybody so that the thinking and speaking skills of students improve.

Module: JUST A MINUTES (JAM)

- Gauge level of vocabulary andknowledge of English.
- Improve Body Language -hand gestures & facialexpression are important for aTeacher.
- · Speech Delivery and Expression- identify areas forimprovement.
- Creative Ability asset of teacher.
- · Sequencing of Ideas.

This was the last part of the workshop to make participants to understand that only having goal is not an achievement but also we should have the passion, hard work and continuous effort to achieve the desired goal. Total 53students had participated in the workshop. All the students were very satisfied and happy and interested to have more session like this in future.



SEMINAR & CONFERENCE COMMITTEE REPORT

Career Counseling Webinar on 15th April, 2021

Seedling School of Law and Governance, Jaipur National University, successfully arranged a 'Career Counselling Seminar' through webinar on 15th April, 2021 in its Permanent Campus at Jaipur National University. The program was organized under the coordination of Dr. S.Krishnan, Associate Professor, Seedling School of Law and Governance under the supervision of Professor Dr. V.K. Singh, Director of Seedling School of Law and Governance (SSLG). The speaker of this program included Dr. Ranjana Kaul, Partner in the Dua Associates, Delhi. The speakerenlightened the aspirant law students of SSLG about potential career paths in the legal arena and beyond i.e. judiciary, bar, academia, corporate sector, development sector, etc.

The program started with the welcome speech by Professor Dr V.K. Singh. Dr. Krishnan highlighted about the importance of this program. The aim of this learning session is to enlighten the law students of SSLG with detailed accounts of legal career prospect. Dr. Kaul fostered the skills to comprehend and diagnose the intricacies of various legal and other inter-disciplinary issues and devise solutions to these problems through analysis and reasoning. Dr. Kaul explained taxation as a bright career option for a law student. They also discussed the changing nature of taxation law over a period of time. One requires creative analytical skill to succeed in this field. They also cleared some of the myths that a student generally has related to tax as a career for the law student.

In addition to introducing the profession of corporate lawyers, Dr Kaul also introduced on a career in a law firm. According to her, students should not only be satisfied with knowledge in the classroom but also must develop themselves. Social activities, verbal communication skills, and dexterity are the capital of a corporate lawyer. She pointed out, "For students to do internship with the law firms, they must do well and should conduct themselves in a dignified manner. The students must keep an open mind and explore subjects like company law or taxation laws, keeping in mind of the national and international perspectives."

Dr Kaul discussed career options like law firms and consulting firms, litigation and court practice, academia, judiciary, civil service and international civil service. She urged the students to focus on language and communication skills, maintain decorum skills, demeanour in their career, must do research and understand how Indian statutes have a bearing on International perspectives.

Finally, gratitude was shown to the respected speaker for her wonderful participation in the event. This session concluded with the Q&A session.



Seedling School of Law and Governance organized webinar session on "JUDICIAL SERVICE EXAMINATIONS" on 17th August, 2020 with guest speaker Justice Kishan Sandu, (Training).

Justice Kisan Sandu spoke about the working OF Judicial System of India, Supreme Court, High Court, District Court, and Subordinate Courts. He also spoke about law and rules, challenging cases as a judge, a career in the Indian judiciary system, life after being in judiciary services, Job role and duties as a District & Sessions Judge.

Sandu said that the Judicial Services Examination provides a secure and comfortable tenure. Besides, it gives an opportunity to the selected candidates to serve the country. Around 50,000 to 60,000 candidates appear for Judicial Services Examination each year, but only those like Sandu who studied with a purpose and according to a plan, succeed. "In order to succeed in Judicial Services Examination, a candidate can either adopt the self-study mechanism or can take the assistance of a coaching institute. I joined a coaching institute in Delhi, which guided me throughout my preparation. For the Preliminary examination, the focus remains on the bare Act study thoroughly whereas, with regard to mains examination, conceptual clarity about the various concepts of law is needed," says Kishan Sandu. "As far as the interview is concerned, apart from the thorough knowledge about the current affairs as well as the basic general knowledge, the focus should be on various important concepts of laws as prescribed under IPC, CPC, CRPC and Evidence Act," he added.

The session was very interactive and students came up with questions.






